About Craig Roseneder



Craig Roseneder was devoted to the development of a safer road transport industry. His passion, excellence and his experience combined to create a unique approach to the resolution of challenges which confronted the industry.

Craig worked with Nolans in Gatton, Queensland, from 1986 to 1997. During this period he rose from mechanic to workshop foreman. He orchestrated a number of major projects that would change the platform of safety and compliance as we knew it. Such projects included the early development of the TruckSafe accreditation scheme with the introduction of the first accredited module, maintenance, and industry specific fatigue management programs.

In 1997, Craig commenced work with the Australian Trucking Association. He continued to

work tirelessly in the development of the industry's accreditation standards: standards which addressed the need for improved safety, maximum productivity and world's best practice of road freight efficiency.

Craig moved to National Transport Insurance and in a risk management role, he continued his work with the ATA and many government and industry based associations. During this time he fulfilled his dream to create a world recognised, computer based fatigue management training package.

Craig died on 26 October, 1999 at the age of 39. Those who spent time with him valued his kindness and friendship, his professionalism and his willingness to contribute to those around him. For others it will be Craig's role in industry development that will stand as his epitaph.

The Technical & Maintenance Award was first awarded in 1998. In 2000, the award was renamed the Craig Roseneder Award for Technical and Maintenance Excellence in the Workshop by an Individual.

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People making a nomination are asked to enter their information into an MS Word document, using the various headings in criteria 1 to 4. The document can then be emailed to the Awards Secretary. This makes for quicker and accurate processing, and avoids handwritten nominations that are faxed or posted. **Thank you**

Conditions of Entry

- 1) The award is open to any individual who works full-time in the Australian trucking industry. Candidates should work for a trucking company, supplier or commercial workshop as a workshop manager, mechanic or provide support within the maintenance field for heavy vehicles.
- 2) Nominations can be made by anyone, and those wishing to nominate themselves can do so.
- 3) Entries must be prepared in an MS Word document and submitted electronically via an email to the Awards Secretary.
- 4) Nominations must address all points outlined in the award criteria
- 5) A recent good quality photograph of the nominee must be included with the nomination or emailed to the Awards Secretary.
- 6) Nominations must be received by the ATA no later than the closing date, Monday 18 October 2010. However, late entries may be accepted at the absolute discretion of the Judges.
- 7) The judges will select one to three finalists subject to the entries meeting the Judges' standards.
- 8) The Judges may choose not to select finalists in the award or to present an award.
- 9) The award will be judged according to the selection criteria.
- 10) The judging panel and/or the ATA will not enter into correspondence regarding the judging process other than to advise nominees and nominators of the success or otherwise of their nomination.
- 11) The prize package is not transferrable and the international travel component must only be used to attend the American maintenance conference.
